

## INDIAN INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, SHIBPUR

### Admission to Full-time PhD programme under “Visvesvaraya PhD scheme (Sponsored by DeitY, MCIT, Govt. of India) 2016-17

Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), MCIT, Govt. of India has granted a total of 22 scholarships under the scheme entitled “Visvesvaraya PhD scheme”. Under this scheme, at present, there are 7 vacant positions for full-time PhD scholars. Applications are invited from Indian nationals for admission to PhD Program for the odd semester 2016-17 to fill-in the 7 vacant positions, under the above scheme at this Institute.

The major features of the scheme for the full-time scholars are given below:

- Monthly scholarship of Rs.31, 250/- per month for first 2 years and Rs. 35,000/- per month for rest 3 years.
- Rent reimbursement up to 30% of scholarship amount paid per month.
- Annual contingency of Rs.30, 000/- .
- Financial Support (up to Rs. 50,000/-) for attending International conferences.

**Eligibility criterion:** Essential: M.Tech (candidates appearing in the examination may also apply) in IT, Electronics, CS, EE and VLSI or equivalent with a minimum of 72.5% or 8.0 CGPA (67.5% or 7.0 CGPA for ST/ST candidates) at both the Bachelor’s (BE/BTech in CS, EE, IT or Electronics) and Master’s level. Candidates with **M Sc** (in CS, Electronics, IT and VLSI with the same percentage of marks or CGPA specified for BE/BTech) degree followed by **M. Tech** degree are also eligible.

**Desirable:** GATE qualification.

**Age:** 32 years as on 1 July 2016; date may be relaxed by 5 years for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/Woman candidate

The above eligibility condition is a minimum requirement only. Good academic career and higher qualification is preferred and mere eligibility does not ensure a call for admission test and/or Interview. A screening of applications will be made to prepare a short list of candidates who will be called for admission test and/or Interview. Further screening will be done after the admission test to select the candidates for the interview.

The area of specializations in the four departments/school with Specializations in the proposed PhD Program is with a tentative allocation (may change) of scholars in each is given below:

- Applicants seeking admission under this scheme are required to apply on-line duly filled-up electronic admission form (with the details of the draft).
- An applicant may make separate applications (with separate draft for each application) to more than one department/school if he/she fulfills the eligibility criteria for that department/school.
- Applicants need to pay Rs. 300/- (Rs. 150/- for the SC/ST/PwD candidates) by demand draft/pay order addressed to “REGISTRAR, IEST, Shibpur” and payable at Kolkata.
- A copy of the submitted application along with the draft (details given by the candidate in the application form) together will be treated as admit card. The draft(s) would be collected from the candidates during the test.
- For candidates appearing in M. Tech. and M. Sc. examinations are required to submit (within September 15, 2016) their marks of the final examination and that would comply the minimum requirement mentioned earlier as the minimum eligibility failing which their candidature will be cancelled and no scholarship will be given to them.

### TEST/INTERVIEW

- Same admission test will be held for each department/school
- 1.5 hr MCQ type with two and a half marks for each correct answer and minus half marks for wrong answer.
- Question will be based on 10+2 level mathematics.
- Interview will be primarily on subjects in B.Tech (M.Sc)/M .Tech level and area of specialisation.
