Instruction (2)

Two/Double Bids:-

01. Tenders will have to be submitted in TWO PARTS i.e. (a) Technical Bid and (b) Price Bid, in two separate properly sealed covers indicating the type of Bid; and both these covers will have to be again put in to a single sealed cover.
