The Tender Evaluation Committee made the following observations:

- 1. Requisite number of bidders did not participate (only two bidders participated) in the Retender process, thus effective competition is lacking;
- 2. The quoted percentage is 18% above the Estimated Rate. The quoted rate is considerably high than the annual value of the project as approved in the Finance Committee and BoG. The reasons of this higher rate may be because of the following reasons:

a) The Estimated Rate is calculated on the basis of Pre GST Taxes wherein combined Sales Tax and VAT @5% were included;

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- b) As mentioned in the NIT, SECTION 1: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB) Sub-Section E. (Bid Opening and Evaluation) clause no. 29.1 (Clarification of Bids) wherein it is stated that "To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of Bids, the Employer may, at his discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification of his Bid, including breakdowns of the unit rates. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or by email, but no change in the price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted." Therefore, there will be no financial benefit of the Institute even if an official communication is sent to the L1 bidder in this regard.
- 3. An approval may be sought from the Finance Committee on increase from the approved project value. But in the current situation of the Institute the occurrence of the next meeting of the Finance Committee is unpredictable.
- 4. As mentioned in the NIT, SECTION 1: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB) Sub-Section E. (Bid Opening and Evaluation) clause no. 27.1 (Employer's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or all Bids) wherein it is stated that "Notwithstanding Clause 26, the Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to cancel the Bidding process and reject all Bids, at any time prior to the award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the Employer's action."

The members of the Tender Evaluation Committee discussed at length the notes and observations mentioned above and recommended to adhere to clause no. 27.1 (Employer's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject any or all Bids) of Sub-Section E. (Bid Opening and Evaluation) of the SECTION 1: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB) of the NIT with Tender Reference No: e-Proc/ DEANIPM 01112017/GARBAGE HEST/72R, Tender ID: 2017 HEST 2262098 1 (Financial bid opened on November 17, 2017) and thus cancel the Bidding process and reject all Bids for the following reasons:.

1) Lack of effective competition in the bidding process; and

2) The quoted rate is considerably higher than the annual value of the project as approved in the Finance Committee and BoG.

The Tender Evaluation Committee also recommends that the extension of service be provided till the end of March, 2018 to the agency presently carrying out the work i.e. Environmental Engineering Services.
