NCS has made available on the portal over 33.58 Lakh vacancies posted by employers from various sectors and the number is steadily growing. The portal also has a rich repository of career content of over 3600 occupations across 52 sectors which can be accessed by the job seekers, employment exchange officers, counsellors and other stakeholders.
