SECTION-I: General Conditions and Important Instructions for Bidders

1. Interested agencies are to download the tender documents with detailed specifications from the institute website (www.iiests.ac.in)
2. It is necessary to submit the original tender documents along with technical/price bids in sealed envelopes to the **Head, Department of Civil Engineering, Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IIEST), Shibpur; Howrah-711103**, or directly to **Drop** in the **Tender Box** kept in the Department.
3. Bidders must have at least 10 years vast experience in the area of Laboratory Analysis of the Water/Air/Soil Samples collected under Baseline Environmental Monitoring Study pertaining to EIA/EMP, particularly for construction of Intake Jetty/Pumping Station.
4. Bidders must be accredited by NABL and certified by West Bengal Pollution Control Board as well as Ministry of Environment and Forest and Climate Change.
5. Bidders are to abide by the terms and condition and submit this tender document in original duly signed with acceptance of the terms and conditions.
6. Last date of receipt of tender is **17th April, 2018 (4:00 pm)**. Tenders received at late will not be accepted under any circumstances. Tenders will be opened in the Seminar Hall of the Civil Engineering Department, on the same day at 4:15 pm. In case the Institute remains closed on the said date, tenders will be opened on next working day at 4:15 pm.
7. The Price Bid should clearly mention the price including the following:
 - Sample Preservation charges.
 - All taxes, duties, levies applicable.
8. The Bidders must have a GST Number, which should be clearly mentioned in the Invoice/Bill.
9. Period of execution of work should be within 12/05/2018 by 5 pm. If the execution is not completed within the stipulated period as indicated in the Work Order a Liquidated Damage @0.5% per week will be imposed on the value of purchase order subject to maximum of 5% of the value of work order.
10. Bills in triplicate should be presented for payment within 15 days of execution of work. No advance will be paid for execution of the order. The Work Order No. is to be noted on the Bill. All bills are to be accompanied by order copies and Completion Certificates.
11. Payment will be made on submission of proper Bills, Completion Certificates etc, by A/C Payee Cheque or Electronic Fund Transfer and no cash payment will be made under any circumstances.
